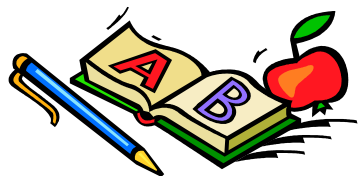


# Do You Have Concerns About...?

# CHILD FIND SERVICES

## SCREENING

Developmental screening in all areas; speech/language, fine motor skills, gross motor coordination, learning, hearing/vision and social adaptability.

## EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT

Intervention support for specific educational concerns; targeted evaluations for children who may require an Individualized Education Plan (IEP); and special education support services.

## CONSULTATION

Information provided to parents about child development, behavior management and community resources.

## COMMUNITY REFERRALS

Information and referrals to community resources which provide a variety of services, including preschool programs.
